Visitor Code of Conduct

Our staff is dedicated to providing the highest quality of care to our residents. Please show them the respect they deserve as they carry out their duties. Visitors who do not comply with this Code of Conduct will be asked to leave the Jewish Home property and may be escorted by security.

For the health, safety, and comfort of all our staff and residents, we ask that residents and visitors follow the guidelines in our Code of Conduct. Expected conduct includes but is not limited to:

- No disruptive, threatening or violent behavior, including the use of obscene language or gestures
- Please show respect for others, building facilities and personal property
- The possession of weapons is not permitted

You will be asked to leave for violating any of the above rules or for the following:

- Your behavior creates a risk or threat to residents, families, or staff
- You are not respectful or considerate of others

Visitor privileges will not be restricted, limited or denied on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, or disability. However, the Home does have the right to restrict visitation based on an individual's behavior and any other circumstances as deemed inappropriate.
